

**AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES
AMENDMENT 1**

This amendment entered into this 15th day of February, 2023 by and between the Village of Endicott, hereinafter called the CLIENT and Hunt Engineers, Architects, Land Surveyors & Landscape Architect D.P.C., hereinafter called the CONSULTANT, amends the New Drinking Water Source Investigation agreement signed and dated August 19, 2021. The amendment to the original scope of services includes, in general, the following items:

1. Add Environmental Review.
2. The location, field work and drilling of a third test well.
3. Expanded pump test and assessment of off site hydraulic impacts as well as the addition of pump testing of the third well.

The total proposed fee for the amended services, including subconsultant fees, is a lump sum fee of Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Thirty dollars. (\$50,530).

Please take notice that Broome County intends to serve as Lead Agency with respect to the environmental review of the Grippen Park and Chugnut Trail Waterfront Improvements Project.

Proposed Action

This project builds on existing plans and leverages current efforts to complete a waterfront enhancement project that expands access, use and connectivity of riverfront resources. Project activities include constructing a segment of the Chugnut Trail, renovating the existing recreational building, making improvements to the trailhead parking lot in Grippen Park, expanding Grippen Park’s playground area, and adding new amenities to the park such as wayfinding signage.

SEQR Classification

Pursuant to Part 617 of the SEQRA, the action is classified as UNLISTED. While coordinated review is not required for unlisted actions under SEQR, Broome County feels it is warranted in this case due to the intermunicipal nature of the project.

Declaration of Intent to Serve as Lead Agency

In accordance with the SEQRA, Broome County desires to conduct a coordinated review among Involved and Interested Agencies, with Broome County serving the role as Lead Agency.

This Notice, accompanied by the Part 1 of the Short EAF and a map of the Project Area is being sent to you and all other Involved and Interested Agencies. Please respond via email or use the enclosed form to indicate your interest and concerns regarding the lead agency designation and the potential environmental impacts of the proposed project. We request that you submit your form at your earliest convenience, but no later than April 17, 2023. Should you not respond within thirty (30) calendar days from the date shown above, Broome County will assume that your agency has no interest in the choice of lead agency or comments regarding the SEQR review of this project and no future notifications will be forwarded to you on this matter.
