RE: Engineering Planning Grant (EPG) 120351

Dear Mayor and Board of Trustees,

The Village was awarded an EPG of \$100,000 from NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation for our Flow Management Plan Implementation – Phase 2 Project. This project will involve the inspection and assessment of areas within both the Village's and T. Vestal's collection systems. The Village must provide a signed agreement in order to proceed.

The engineering agreement's total project cost will not exceed \$217,000 (\$100,000 grant, \$64,000 from Village and \$54,000 from T. Vestal). The Village is the lead agency for the project and will be administering the project for the Village and T. Vestal. The Village's portion will come from the Wastewater Department's budget line I/I (G8130.2210).

This project will allow the Village to continue working towards our Flow Management Plan goals by identifying sources of Inflow and Infiltration within the Village's and T. Vestal's collection systems.
