## Interested in requesting a change to a parking law in the Village of Endicott? Here's the process...

Chapter 235 of the Endicott Village Code contains the parking laws in the Village of Endicott. These laws can be amended by Local Law adopted by the Village Board of Trustees. There are 3 ways to initiate such a change:

- 1. <u>Board of Trustees</u>: The Village Board of Trustees can approve a motion to initiate a change in the parking laws; or
- 2. <u>Planning Board</u>: The Planning Board can approve a motion recommending the Village Board of Trustees to initiate a change in the parking laws; or
- 3. <u>Citizen</u>: Anyone can submit a petition to the Board of Trustees requesting an amendment to the parking laws. The petition must be typewritten and signed and acknowledged by the person or persons presenting it and by the owners of more than 75% of the area for which change is petitioned, in the same manner as required for the recording of a deed to real property, and shall be filed with the Village Clerk in triplicate. Persons petitioning for a change in the traffic or parking regulations shall, at the time application is made for such change, deposit with the Village Treasurer the sum of \$50 for the payment of the cost of processing, reviewing and advertising for a public hearing and such other expenses incidental thereto. Such deposit is nonrefundable.
