**Re: Proposal for Engineering Services
Lone Pine Water Storage Tank Replacement
Village of Endicott, Broome County, New York**

Dear Mr. Pero:

The Lone Pine Water storage tank was constructed in 1988 and has exhibited shortcomings for many years following its installation. This Peabody TecTank has leaked for many years and has resulted in limited turnover thus raising the question if the tank storage volume can be reduced. Due to the physical shortcomings coupled with the perceived storage volume concerns, the Village desires to replace this 163,485 gallon water storage tank with a new Statewide Aquastore water storage tank. As a result, Hunt Engineers, Architects, Land Surveyors & Landscape Architect DPC (HUNT) proposes the following scope of services:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. Conduct a kick-off meeting with the Village. HUNT shall arrive at this meeting prepared with a plan of the existing project site and review the various alternatives available for construction of a replacement water storage tank. These alternatives include:
 - Replacing the Lone Pine water storage tank on the same footprint as the existing tankage
 - Construction of a new tank immediately adjacent to the existing tank.
2. Hunt shall evaluate each aforementioned alternatives, develop a cost estimate of each and develop consensus with the Village water department as to the preferred scenario.
3. HUNT shall obtain any and all needed property boundary and topographic survey mapping necessary to identify the tank site and surrounding ground elevations influencing construction.
4. HUNT shall finalize a conceptual plan of the preferred option. This conceptual plan shall be provided to the Village for input and utilized to identify the tank location.

III. COMPENSATION

HUNT will perform the proposed survey, design and regulatory submission, outlined in the above listed Scope of Services, for a fee of thirty-four thousand two hundred dollars (\$34,200). Project-related disbursements such as plotting, photocopies, prints as are not included in below fees above and will be billed as they are incurred.

If the proposal is acceptable, please sign and return the attached agreement. HUNT appreciates the opportunity to assist the Village. If you have any questions concerning this proposal, please do not hesitate to call me at 607-769-1024.
