Garbage and Recycling is regulated by Chapter 211 – Solid Waste of the Code of the Village of Endicott

DO'S & DON'TS for GARBAGE

- **DO** Set out containers at curb by 7:00 AM but no more than 24 hrs. before pickup day & remove 24 hrs. after pickup.
- **DO** Limit to 3 containers per dwelling unit.
- **DO** Use cans with a tight-fitting lid.
- **DO** Set out up to three pieces of household furniture with regular garbage.
- **DO** Carpets needs to be cut into 6x6 foot pieces, rolled and placed neatly at the curb.
- **DO** Replace leaking or defective containers.
- **DON'T** Use cans larger than 35 gallons
- DON'T Exceed the 50 lb. limit per can
- **DON'T** Place garbage in paper bags or Cardboard boxes.
- **DON'T** Place electronics such as TV's, computers, monitors and printers.
- **DON'T** Place deceased domestic animals for collection.
- DON'T Mix garbage with yard waste.
- **DON'T** Include items that are not the product of the ordinary conduct of households such as yard waste, stones, items from demolition or remodeling, concrete
- **DON'T** Include tires or automotive parts

DO'S & DON'TS for RECYCLING

- **DO** Set out containers at curb by 7:00 AM but no more than 24 hrs. before pickup day & removed 24 hrs. after pickup.
- **DO** Use recycling containers provided for designated recyclable materials only.
- **DO** Recycle unbroken glass, plastic bottles jugs and containers, food cans and paper products (food, beverage, detergent, & shampoo containers).
- **DO** Rinse glass, cans and plastic items.
- **DO** Flatten cardboard and bundle no larger than 36" x 36" x 18".
- **DO** Include single layer cardboard that is gray or brown.
- **DON'T** Include plastic bags, Styrofoam, unmarked plastic.
- **DON'T** Include wax coated cardboard boxes.
- **DON'T** Include windows, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs, mirrors, cookware, household dishes and glassware.
- **DON'T** Include metal or plastic pipes.
- **DON'T** Include spray cans, pesticide cans or paint cans.
- **DON'T** Include auto fluids and containers.
- **DON'T** Include medical waste and household hazardous waste.
- DON'T Include batteries of any kind.
- **DON'T** Include vehicular tires.

When in doubt ... throw it out.

**Yard Waste is collected on <u>Fridays</u> April through November

Except Holiday weeks**

DO'S & DON'TS for **YARD WASTE**

- **DO** Set out containers by 7:00 AM Fridays but no more than 24 hrs. before pickup day & remove 24 hrs. after pickup.
- **DO** Use 35 gal. open containers or biodegradable bags for small yard waste such as grass, leaves, small sticks and weeds (50 lb. limit each).
- **DO** Brush must be tied with twine/rope in bundles no longer than 6 ft. in length with all branches in one direction (50 lb. limit each).
- **DO** Brush with thorns must be bundled separately or placed in a container or biodegradable bag.
- **DO** Limit containers to 3 per week.
- DO Place leaves in neat piles at the curb from September 1st to December 1st only for pick by vacuum / loader, weather permitting.
- DON'T Place anything over 2 inches in

diameter. Branches and small trunks between 2 and 12 inches in diameter, less than 50 lbs. call 607-757-2429 to schedule a pick up or chipping. Place at curb/sidewalk with cut ends facing street. **DON'T** Put out yard waste for pickup from December through March.

- **DON'T** Put leaves in piles at the curb from January to August for pick up by vacuum/loader.
- **DON'T** Put yard waste in plastic garbage bags or cardboard boxes.
- **DON'T** Include cardboard boxes, plastic bags or other garbage or recycling in yard waste
- **DON'T** Bundle brush or branches over 3" in diameter.

DO'S & DON'TS for WHITE GOODS

(Lg. Household Appliances, and Metal Items)

- **DO** Will be collected on Fridays by appointment only, except Holiday weeks. Call 607-757-2429 for a pickup.
- **DO** Set out items at curb between 7:00 AM Thursday and by 7:00 AM Friday.
- **DO** Remove doors from all appliances to keep children and animals from being trapped inside.

(Refrigerators and freezers have a fee for Freon removal.)

- **DON'T** Store appliances outside where they are an eyesore.
- **DON'T** Include water heaters without having obtained a building permit to replace the unit.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION (C & D)

<u>** The Village of Endicott does not</u> <u>pick up construction debris **</u>

> C & D materials include:

- Bricks, concrete, masonry.
- Wood and wood waste (windows, doors, etc.) wood sheathing, dimensional limber, cabinets.
- Bath tubs, sinks, toilets, hot tubs, (with fixtures removed).
- Wall coverings, plaster, drywall, gypsum products.
- Electrical wiring and components containing no hazardous liquids.
- Plumbing fixtures, pipes, water heaters, boiler, and furnaces.
- Lighting fixtures.
- Non-asbestos insulation, roofing and siding.

> To dispose of construction debris:

- Bring to the **Broome County Landfill** located at 286 Knapp Rd., Binghamton, NY 13905.

 - Call or check Broome County website for a list of fees.

- Bring to the Town of Union facility on Scarborough Drive
 - There is a fee of \$20 cash per in bound trip (1) visit per month up to a maximum of one cubic yard of material.
 - **\$10.00** per television dropped off.
 - \$3 per tire (off the rim)

> You must show proof of residency

C & D material from Contractors or Tradesmen will not be accepted at the Town of Union Facility. You need to take it to the Broome County Landfill.

> Village of Endicott employees collecting your Refuse, Recycling and Yard Waste must deal with all types of weather (heat, cold, rain, snow) and they are operating large pieces of equipment.

By abiding by the rules and regulations for Refuse, Recycling and Yard Waste collection, we can make collection as efficient as possible and keep the men and women on the trucks safe.
